

PRELIMINARY MARKET CONSULTATION RESULTS REPORT ON THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF A FIRE SIMULATOR ON AIRCRAFT FOR FIRE BRIGADE AND EMERGENCY BRIGADE TRAINING FOR THE JOVELLANOS INTEGRAL MARITIME SAFETY CENTRE.

Legal framework and background:

Law 9/2017, of 8 November, on Public Sector Contracts, regulates the preliminary market consultation as an instrument aimed at achieving more effective and efficient public procurement, as a fundamental part of proper planning and preparation of public procurement procedures, since it allows the contracting body to know the advances, alternatives, new developments and prices of the market to identify needs and define in the specifications the characteristics of the object to be contracted, without violating the principles of transparency, free competition, equality and non-discrimination between bidders.

Specifically, Article 115 states that "Contracting authorities may carry out market studies and conduct consultations with economic operators active on the market in order to prepare the tendering procedure properly and inform the said economic operators of their plans and of the requirements they will have to meet in order to take part in the procedure. To this end, contracting authorities may seek the advice of third parties, which may be independent experts or authorities, professional associations or, exceptionally, economic operators active on the market (...)".

The Management of the Jovellanos Integral Maritime Safety Centre, prior to the preparation of the specifications and publication of the tender and with the aim of promoting the participation of economic operators active in the market in the presentation of proposals that respond to the following Technological Challenge: Design, construction and installation of an aircraft simulator to carry out training tasks for Fire and Emergency Brigade teams, convened the Preliminary Market Consultation on April 17TH 2023.

2. Procedure

The implementation of the CPM took place in the following phases:

- Publication of the call for tenders on the State Procurement Platform in the SASEMAR contracting profile and in the European Tenders Electronic Daily (TED) on 17/04/2023.
- Delivery of an online briefing in English: on 24/04/2023, at 10:00 am.

- Deadline for submission and closure of the CPM on 22/05/2023 at 23:59 hours.
